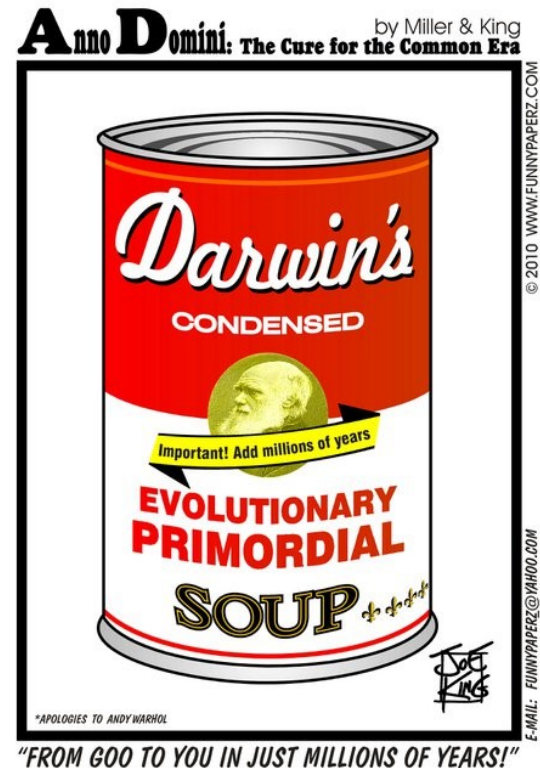

Beginning in 2019, our sermon series has been titled, **GOOD THINKING**. We have been comparing how the world views relationships, changes of heart, dealing with problems, etc., with Godly views. We are discovering how God views these issues differently from the expectations found in the world.

On Sunday, February 3rd, our topic will be focusing on Leaving a Legacy. Often when this subject is mentioned, people may begin to think about financial concerns, about inheritances, or maybe a memorial towards a charity, or some institution.

Our sermon on legacies takes a different approach. Instead of simply considering investing our finances we will consider what it means to invest our lives. When you leave this earth, what will people remember about you? I have asked several people how they would like to be remembered when they die and I have received a variety of answers from “she was a good person”, “he was a generous person”, and more.

So how would you like to be remembered? What do you want to leave in people’s memories of you after you leave this world? On the 3rd, we will consider what it means to leave a Godly legacy when investing our lives. In other words, what might God want us to leave behind - what would God like others to remember about us?

We are going to focus our efforts on where we are going, rather than what we are leaving behind. To have a legacy worth leaving we will want to have a clear picture of where we are going or we might just leave a legacy that is far different than what we hoped. It will very likely be different that the plans that God has for us.
