

On Sunday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, our topic will be focusing on Leaving a Legacy. Often when this subject is mentioned, people may begin to think about financial concerns, about inheritances, or maybe a memorial towards a charity, or some institution.

Our sermon on legacies takes a different approach. Instead of simply considering investing our finances we will consider what it means to invest our lives. When you leave this earth, what will people remember about you? I have asked several people how they would like to be remembered when they die and I have received a variety of answers from "she was a good person", "he was a generous person", and more.

So how would you like to be remembered? What do you want to leave in people's memories of you after you leave this world? On the 3<sup>rd</sup>, we will consider what it means to leave a Godly legacy when investing our lives. In other words, what might God want us to leave behind - what would God like others to remember about us?

We are going to focus our efforts on where we are going, rather than what we are leaving behind. To have a legacy worth leaving we will want to have a clear picture of where we are going or we might just leave a legacy that is far different than what we hoped. It will very likely be different that the plans that God has for
